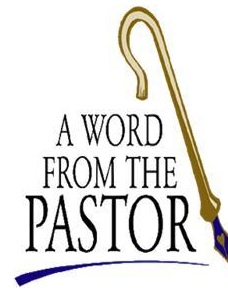

Love is nothing new. Love is what the cross is all about. "Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friend," (Jn. 15:13, ESV). As you know, we are making revisions that will include the Pastor, Chair and Vice-Chair (formerly the Moderator), Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer, Financial Secretary and Assistant Financial Secretary, Sunday School Superintendent and Assistant, three (3) Christen Education Facilitators, three (3) Trustee Facilitators, and three (3) Diaconate Facilitators.

The last time that the constitution was amended was 2007. You are already seeing some different terms used. We have had Saturday meetings in order to have this completed before our Church Council meeting April 13, 2016. Once we have brought this to the members of the Boards and the Committee members, we will be happy to discuss this and answer questions. If all of this meets with everyone's approval, we will discuss further with all the members of the church.
