Those weeds that end up in our garden, don't just pull them. That is not our job. Our job is to point to Jesus, because each and every one of those weeds were put there on purpose. I ended our parable section talking about the Kingdom of God.

Apparently, most of you have never heard the joke about the Baptists in Room number 8. It is worth repeating.
