


This monthly update is bringing good news of a lot of improvements to the Parsonage in anticipation of the move-in of our Interim Pastor, Rev. John Tharp and his wife, Nancy. By the time you read this article, the following accomplishments will be complete: New roof; kitchen gutted and new sheetrock, floor, lighting, cabinets and appliances installed; new washer & dryer; hardwood floors refinished; some windows repaired; new bathroom fixtures and shower update; ceilings and walls repainted; several furniture, bedding, dishes, lamps, cooking utensils, supplies, etc. donated; new carpeting on stairs & upstairs bedrooms; some new venetian blinds; electric & plumbing upgrades; new hot water heater; eventual phone & computer capability added. Some of this has been professionally completed, but a great deal of it has been done by dedicated volunteer labor. We're sure everyone will be pleased with final results!
