June 28th, 1946, the 100th Anniversary closed with a banquet by the Ladies Auxiliary. This was an active, busy group that eventually made a huge change.

In May 1963, the organization was changed to the "Women's Society" with four circles; Lois, Lydia, Eunice, and Phoebe. Morning, afternoon, and evening meetings each month and Society Meetings quarterly.

Officers were: President, Missions, Church Service, Christian Training, and Secretary/Treasurer.
